Guidelines

Product specifications: Provide clear and easy to understand product specifications to your supplier. This can include design drawings, technical drawings, bill of materials, packaging design files, and logo/artwork files. You must also inform the supplier of compliance requirements, such as safety standards and labeling requirements.

Product Samples: Always order product samples before you place a real order from a supplier, regardless of their claimed or actual capabilities.

Payment: You should only pay to a bank account matching the suppliers registered company name. Do not pay to bank accounts with a different beneficiary. Further, you should only pay a 30 to 50% deposit to the supplier - never pay everything upfront.

Quality Inspections: You should always arrange a quality inspection before you pay the balance to your supplier. You may not be able to get a refund or arrange returns.
